From there, you can enter your child's username and password to log in, and you can also sign up to receive e-mails whenever new grades are posted.

By signing this form, you are consenting to the rules of use of www.clintonpublicschools.com as well as PowerSchool, the database system where your child's grades are stored. To view the district's Acceptable Use Policy, visit our Web site, click on "For Parents" on the top left side, and click on "Acceptable Use Policy." This policy was approved by our school board and went into effect in May 2009, and it sets guidelines for proper use as well as penalties for misuse of district technology.

Once you receive your child's login information, it is your responsibility to keep up with his or her username and password. However, if you lose this information or otherwise have trouble logging into Power School, please call your child's school for assistance.

Our school district has never given parents this level of access to their children's grades. This system (as well as parent access to teacher class pages) is a great way for you to keep track of what's going on in your child's classroom and monitor their progress — without having to wait for a report card.

We hope you'll take advantage of these technology upgrades. Involved parents are key to student achievement, and these tools are an easy way for you to stay involved.
