PROCEDURES FOR

PROOF OF RESIDENCY

Before any student is assigned to or invited to attend a Clinton Public School, the student's parent or legal guardian must prove legal residence within the school district's boundaries. Families whose primary residence is outside of the boundaries are **NOT** eligible to attend Clinton Schools.

All applicants must submit at least **two** proofs of residency.

Documents must be pre-printed with the name and address of the student's parent or guardian* and must be presented at the child's school at the time of registration.

These documents are also required for any change of address during the school year. **All applicants must submit at least one document from each of the following columns:**

Column A	Column B
 Copy of Deed or Mortgage Copy of Lease (must list children as tenants) 	A utility bill or start order dated within the past 90 days, including: o Gas bill o Electric bill o Water bill
