Dear CHS Arrow Students and Families,

After a challenging 2020/2021 school year it is my sincere hope that our students and families have found time this summer to relax and recharge. School officials have been working diligently all summer to prepare for the upcoming year. As we continue to navigate the COVID-19 pandemic, various health and safety guidelines will still be in place at CHS. One important change made this summer was the installation of Needlepoint Bipolar Ionization in all HVAC units at CHS. This technology works by safely distributing charged ions into the air that kill airborne pathogens. The result is cleaner and healthier air inside our buildings and classrooms. The health of our students and staff remains a top priority at Clinton High School.

As we near the return to school, we want you to be aware of important upcoming dates. Students return to school on Wednesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>. Registration for returning 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade students are scheduled as follows:

- Sophomores – August 3<sup>rd</sup> from 1:00p to 3:30p
- Juniors – August 4<sup>th</sup> from 8:30a – 11:00a
- Seniors – August 4<sup>th</sup> from 1:00p – 3:30p

Before attending registration, it is imperative that all parents/guardians complete the pre-registration process for your student(s). Completing this online process before you arrive for registration will ensure your time is efficiently spent during registration.

Parents/Guardians, please visit [www.clintonpublicschools.com](http://www.clintonpublicschools.com), click the black square at the top of the page titled “2020-2021 Returning Student Registration” and complete the online forms in their entirety. If this is not completed before your arrival at registration, we will provide you with an iPad to access and complete this important process. Please know, students will not be allowed to complete the online pre-registration process without a parent or guardian present.

For a second straight year, The Mississippi Department of Education is waiving the requirement for students to prove residency on an annual basis. The only exception is students whose address has changed since August 2020 and/or students utilizing an affidavit for residency purposes. Any students who fall under either of these categories will need to prove residency before, or during, registration. Families who need to submit an affidavit will need to do so on August 4 at The Clinton Schools Central Office building

located at 201 Easthaven Drive. Any student not falling under one of these categories will not need to prove residency for the 2021/2022 school year.

Another important step of registration is to pay the annual \$50 Student Instructional fee. As with the online pre-registration, this can be done before arriving for registration. Parents/Guardians can visit their My School Bucks account (accessible through the Power School Parent Portal) to pay this required fee prior to registration. During registration students will be able to pay via My School Bucks, cash, check, or money order. Unfortunately, we will not be able to accept debit/credit card payments. We will also have waiver forms and Free/Reduced Lunch forms available for families needing to utilize this option. Please bring the appropriate documentation with you if plan to submit a waiver.

For students who are new to the Clinton Public School District and Clinton High School, please contact our counseling department at 601-924-5443 to schedule an appointment with your child's counselor. All enrollment of new students will be done by appointment only. Your counselor will provide you with all the necessary information for enrolling your student and set a time for you to come and complete the process.
